

Professor Pollio joined the Department of Modern and Classical Languages and Literatures at Christopher Newport University in the fall of 2004. He teaches courses on classical Greek and Latin, Classical Mythology, and English etymology; he is also helping to implement minor programs in both Latin and Classical Studies. Professor Pollio received his PhD from Bryn Mawr College in 2002, with a dissertation that focused on persuasive speech in Vergil's *Aeneid*. His research focuses primarily on the poetry of Vergil, Ovid, and Homer and encompasses theoretical approaches to the interpretation of Greek and Latin literature.
